



PROTECT YOUR POSSESSIONS

Property crimes such as Theft, Housebreaking, Shoplifting, Handbag/cellphone snatching and Theft out of Motor Vehicles lead to unnecessary suffering.

Taking care of your valuables plays an important role in bringing down property crimes.

- Don't buy stolen goods;
- Never leave your door keys hanging in the door. It is easy to make duplicate keys for later easy access to one's premises.
- If you buy luxury goods, cut up the boxes and dispose of them in tied black bags – a branded box is a tell-tale sign of what thieves could find in your house.
- Never leave your car keys in the ignition – **even for a few seconds.**
- Never leave valuable items on your car seat. Rather keep them in the boot of your car.
- Never leave your wallet in the back pocket of your trousers or leave your handbag unattended.
- Always mark your property and keep records of the make and serial numbers.
